



## UNSHAKABLE WORSHIP

*Psalm 136:1 (AMP)*

***“O GIVE thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever.”***

In Psalm 136, we are exhorted to give thanks to God in all circumstances because His mercy and lovingkindness endures forever. In fact, the psalmist repeats the truth of God’s enduring mercy and loving-kindness 26 times! The word lovingkindness has a very special meaning and in Hebrew is *chesed*. Derek Prince states that the best way to interpret *chesed* is “God’s covenant-keeping faithfulness”. He goes on to explain that “in every situation and in every circumstance, we are exhorted to see God’s covenant-keeping faithfulness, whether it’s in creation, whether it’s in redemption or whether it’s in judgment. God’s covenant-keeping faithfulness is demonstrated in all these.”

Unshakable worship is not based on circumstances or feelings, but on the unchangeable nature of our covenant-keeping, faithful God. For “we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.”

(Romans 8:28 NLT) God is sovereign, ruler of all, seer of everything, master of the universe. He is also a very good and loving Father, a gentle shepherd, faithful and just, merciful and kind.

Whenever I don’t feel like praise and worshiping God, I remember the example David gave in Psalms 103:1-12 (NKJV) and I become an unshakable worshipper!

CHOOSE to WORSHIP - “Bless the LORD, O my soul; and ALL that is within me, bless His holy name!”

REMEMBER & LIST - “Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits:”

- Who forgives all your iniquities
- Who heals all your diseases
- Who redeems your life from destruction
- Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies
- Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.
- The LORD executes righteousness And justice for all who are oppressed.
- He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the children of Israel.
- The LORD is merciful and gracious, Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy. He will not always strive with us, Nor will He keep His anger forever.
- He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor punished us according to our iniquities.
- As the heavens are high above the earth, so great is His mercy toward those who fear Him
- As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

At all times, in every season, our God is the same! He never changes! His love remains!  
His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever! He is our faithful covenant keeping Father!!
